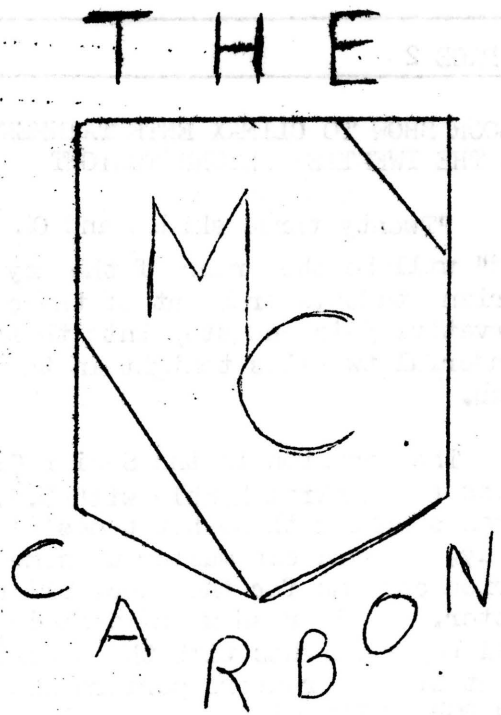


**HAIL MARY, FULL OF GRACE**
