# Solution - Two Beneficial Teaching Practices

- Problem-Centered: Students engaged in authentic, complex, real-world problems to which they apply the discipline.
- **Transparent:** Not just the what, but also the why and how of learning experiences

- Quality of student work
- Student persistence and retention

#### Results of TILT

- Increased motivation
- Higher quality of student work
- Fewer challenges to grades
- Self-reported awareness of improvement of skills valued by employers, like working in groups and written and oral communication
- Improved sense of academic confidence
- Improved sense of belonging

"...a higher sense of belonging and academic confidence correlated to improved GPA and retention rates, as previous research studies have indicated."
